Moira has been involved in the local music scene around Melbourne's northern suburbs for the past four years, performing with 'The Swinging Jugs', playing covers of alt-country/blues music (Johnny Cash, Steve Earle, Lucinda Williams, Bob Dylan, etc.)

She has been writing songs informally for most of her life, and has focused in recent times on songwriting and local performances.

In the last couple of years Moira has been writing many original songs, some of which appear on her new CD 'One Step Forward'. She plays guitar, fiddle, keyboard and accordion and uses the influences of Lucinda Williams, Kasey Chambers, Joni Mitchell, and Emmylou Harris to name a few.

Moira uses her life experiences as a more mature woman to reflect a diverse 'feel' in her music, and range from wistful ditties about getting older, to blues about the menopause, to catchy ballads about 'love gone wrong', to songs about the birth of her children, to social commentary.
